

Colorado Cup Check In Instructions

REQUIRED DOCUMENTS: (All documents must be digital to upload to Got Soccer)

OFFICIAL STATE LEAGUE Roster- must include coach and assistant coaches specifically those that will be coaching at the tournament. Submitted roster must be signed/stamped by club registrar.

Rosters missing registrar's signature will not be accepted. (Player and coach passes are not required if names are on the official roster.) All players should be verified by CSA.

GUEST PLAYER FORM – limit of 5 guest players per U9/U10 team and 4 guest players per U8 team.

Rosters are not to exceed a maximum of 12 players for U9/U10 teams and 10 players for U8 teams. **Each guest player must have a LAMINATED Player Pass with picture if player has not been added to your official state roster.**

MEDICAL RELEASE – forms are required for each player on the team, including guest players. The Medical Release form must be signed either electronically or by hand, US Soccer or medical release provided by your club's database (ie: GOT Soccer) The form **does NOT need to be notarized. All medical releases need to be scanned together into one document**

2019 CSA CUP Team Information Form: this form must be completed in its entirety and signed .

UPLOADING INSTRUCTIONS:

- Save or Scan all required documents into pdf format
 - There is 1-4 documents depending on scanning method and requirements
- Follow this link to login to your Got Soccer team account

- Select Teams & Team Officials
- Under team account use the same login used to register for the tournament
- Click on 2019 Colorado Cup
- Click on the tab marked Documents
- Select Choose File under Team Document Upload , complete File Name/Description(ex. U9B Colorado United Nike Academy Force), then click upload file and upload all needed documents. You will need to convert your document to a pdf prior to upload and save on your computer)

Official Tournament Rosters and Guest Player Rosters will be stamped and uploaded by the tournament, after check-in is complete. Teams will be notified when their tournament rosters are ready to be printed from your team account using the same process above. **You will be required to give the Official Tournament Roster to the referee before each game.**
